1. Consider the definition of “prosecutor” in section 6 of the Criminal Disclosure Act 2008: do you agree with the Solicitor-General that lawyers employed to present the case for the Crown is the person in charge of the file? What are your reasons.
2. Outline the main consequences of the *Brady* principles in the USA: consider how you could argue that the same principles arise in New Zealand.
3. Consider the question of disclosure and relevance to the case. What arguments are there for taking an approach based on relevance to ensure that there are no miscarriages of justice arising from non-disclosure?
